INFORMATION ABOUT OUR SHOW

WELCOME!

Welcome to Llamageddon! Or maybe the Alpacalypse! It has been 23 years since Clinton County Lama Club has been formed and we are excited to start our 23rd Lama Show. The Clinton County Lama club has changed a little each year and we hope that it will continue to grow as the years come and go.

WHY LAMAS?

As you may have noticed already, Lama Club is just a little different than most animal clubs. We do have a showmanship class, but we also have performance classes. Read on to figure out what each class is about!

SHOWMANSHIP

This class is being judged on how well the handler shows their animal. When the judge talks to the handler, she will ask them a question about their animal. It will test the 4Her's knowledge!

PACK

This class is set up to simulate everyday situations that the lama and handler would experience. Some of the things you might see them doing include stepping through deadfall, loading a pack, or walking under branches.

OBSTACLE

This class is set up to simulate everyday situations that a lama might encounter. Some of the things you might see the animal doing include jumping, backing, or change of pace.

PUBLIC RELATIONS

This class is set up to simulate everyday situations that the lama and handler would experience during a public event, such as nursing homes, parades, school visits, and other public places. Some of the things you might see them doing include going over steps, asking to pet the animal, or putting on a partial costume.

COSTUME

This class is judged on how much of the lama's body is covered, how the animal reacts to the costume, the theme of the overall costume, and their narrative. This year, club members dressed up their llamas before the show and took pictures.

GROUND DRIVING

This class is set up to help an animal learn to pull a cart. The animal handler has worked with their animal to train it to walk or run, turn left or right, and weave through patterns. Each animal handler also has a "groom", which is the person in front of the animal. The groom is not leading the animal, but is set in place as a safety should the animal get spooked. This class is optional and doesn't happen every year depending on participation.

OVERALL HIGH POINT MEMBER

This award is given to the member with the highest points awarded. Lama Club Members can earn points for attending meetings and workshops, completing their record books and record sheets, placings for craft or poster projects, placings during show days, and overall fair attitude and work ethic. This member will have their name displayed in the Show Arena year round!

SHOW ORDER

The order of the show is as follows: we will start with Showmanship (Junior, Intermediate, Senior, Master, & Mini). Depending on who our master showman is, either intermediate or senior performance will follow showmanship. We will start with whichever class our master showman shows to allow them the rest of the day to prepare for Supreme Showmanship this evening. After the first performance class is over, the mini exhibitors will complete their performance class. We will end our show with the remaining two classes of performance. In order to finish our show on time, all 3 rings will be set up and the exhibitor will complete all 3 performance classes one right after the other.
