General Show Information

1. Entry Rules
 - a. All entries must be in place by 5:00 pm on Friday, April 12, 2024 in order to be included in the show program. Money must be received with the entry by this time or the entry will be considered invalid.
 - b. Any late entries will have a \$25 late fee in addition to the registration fees.
 - c. This show is open to any llama/alpaca exhibitor in or out of the state of Indiana who meets the age requirements for any class he/she enters.
 - d. Animals may be shown once per class in each section.
 - e. Female and non-breeding male llamas and alpacas, registered and non-registered, are all eligible for entry. No intact males over 2 years old in any division.
2. Show superintendents reserve the right to combine, divide, or rearrange classes as deemed appropriate to the expediency of the show.
3. Exhibitors must provide their own bedding and clean their pen before leaving.
4. All animals will be inspected for signs of communicable disease. Any animal deemed unhealthy for any reason will not be allowed to be allowed to participate in the show. Note: Out of state animals must have health papers to present upon registration.
5. Animals can be furnished to show that day if travel is difficult or 4-H animal has not been obtained yet. Please note on your registration form if you need an animal provided for you.

Classes

1. Contest open to all ages.
2. If enough exhibitors, showmanship class will separate out exhibitors ages 5 and below. Each exhibitor will receive a participation ribbon. An Adult must accompany the exhibitor 5 or under in the show ring.
3. Placings will be given for all other classes.

4. Showmanship and obstacle classes will be split based on registration.
5. Participation in this show is encouraged for 4-H Leaders, parents, and llama lovers who want to know more of what a judge is looking for. You are welcome to share your 4-Hers animal with them to participate in the show.

All Classes

Purpose of this show is to provide instruction on what you can improve on. To meet this goal each exhibitor will have limited one on one time with both the showmanship judge and the obstacle judge. Showmanship and performance classes will run simultaneously. The last obstacle of the performance class will be meeting with the judge and together looking at the score sheet to determine which obstacles were done well and what showman can work on to improve. Each exhibitor will be limited to one showmanship and one performance entry.

Classes will be placed and ribbons will be given.

Shearer will be available this day. See her first thing to schedule a time for your animal to be sheared or determine the order she will shear.

Food will be available the day of the show.

We plan to have some additional educational topics at various times as requested on your surveys last year!
