Minis are allowed to assist their mentor in costume if the mentor chooses to do that.

Posters – be sure that you read directions carefully Elaine is trying to get extra topics allowed for posters and will keep you informed. Right now, we follow Animal Poster rules.

Crafts – If you need any help with crafts let Elaine know. She has several helpers that can give suggestions and help you.

Just a reminder that books and record sheets are due July 1. A leader will sign the record sheet and return it after your points are recorded so that you can turn them in with your project. Points are needed for the overall completion points. You earn points for attending meetings, showing at the fair, filling out your books and record sheets, writing papers and doing your poster and craft.
